CBSE Board Exams 2025 Instructions

- Students must report before the time at the examination centers – the official reporting time is by 9:30 am. Gates of the Examination Centers would be closed at 10:00 am – students would not be allowed to enter after the gates are closed
- Students need to carry their CBSE Roll Number duly signed along with their school identity card or any other official Photo ID card – admit cards not signed would not be considered and the student can be stopped at the gate
- The time of the examination is mentioned in the CBSE Date Sheet as well as the admit cards issued to the students Board Exam begins at 10:30 am and ends at 1:30 pm.
- Students are required to carry the pens and colors as per the requirement of the subject – only the answer sheet and the question paper are provided at the center
- Diabetic students and students with other special medical needs are allowed to carry their medicine and a small snack for the examination
